VISITING THE SCHOOL

To ensure the safety of all our students it is very important that we know who is on the school site at all times. Of course, immediately before and after school we have many parents and caregivers visiting the school and this is expected. We also have occasions when parents/caregivers are invited to attend an event, such as assemblies or sport events. However, outside these 'drop off' and 'pick up' times and 'special occasion times' it is very important that all parents/caregivers who come to the school 'sign in' at the office before going anywhere else on the school site. The 'signing in' involves wearing a visitor sticker. This then helps teachers to ascertain the visitor has recorded their presence at the office.

This does not apply to parents/caregivers who are helping in the class alongside the teacher. As a school we welcome parent/caregiver involvement and this clearly means we will have numerous visitors at school at any given time. With

your help we will always know who is on the school site. This is also useful should an emergency evacuation be needed as we must know how many people need to be accounted for. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation.
