## **NEARLY FIVES**

A special welcome from Browns Bay School is extended to parents/caregivers of 'Nearly Fives'.

Browns Bay School is a large contributing (Yr 1 - Yr 6) Primary School with a roll of around 600. The school is of a single cell nature (1 teacher - 1 class) and classes are generally of a single level where numbers allow.

Parents wishing to have their children attend Browns Bay School must complete an application for enrolment. Please check with the office for specific details. Recent legislation allows for the acceptance of children who live within the defined geographical zone.

Instructions from the Health Funding Authority state that Primary schools are required to keep a register recording the immunisation status (whether immunised or not), of all enrolled children born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 1995. The Immunisation certificate can be found on the back of the Well Child - Tamariki Ora Health book given to parents of every child at birth. Would you kindly present this certificate to the school along with the enrolment form prior to starting school.

The Associate Principal will also arrange to meet with the parents and child, either shortly before the starting date, or on the day of starting. Appointments will be made from approximately 8.15 a.m.
