Dear Parents and Caregivers Kia Ora

STRIKE - SCHOOL CLOSED - WEDNESDAY 29 MAY

The letter below was sent to all parents by email this morning:

The Board of Trustees cannot provide teaching or supervision for students during the upcoming strike.

The NZEI (New Zealand Education Institute) has advised the Board of Trustees that the principal and teachers at our school will be taking strike action on WEDNESDAY MAY 29 for the full day.

The Board has carefully considered the availability of teaching staff, and unfortunately decided that we can't provide the normal teaching services during the strike. It is important that you make alternative arrangements for the care of your child/children on the day of the strike.

The school will need to close during this strike. I know this is inconvenient for parents and students, but please be assured that student safety is our main concern.

You will have noted that this Strike Day is in the same week as our Teacher Only Day. The TOD date was set in late 2018 and with over 500 teachers involved it is too late to change this event. The decision to have a Strike Day on May 29 was beyond our control.

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

At the last Board meeting I presented a report on the results of our student's achievement in two tests that are standard across New Zealand. I am pleased to share the Mathematic results with you from the Progress and Achievement Test (PAT) and the e-asTTle test that students sat in Term 1. I have used the average scaled scores from each year group, compared to the NZ expected score. Please note the scaled scores in PAT differ to e-asTTle.

All Year group's achievement in both assessments were better than the NZ (as shown in black) expected score. Boys and girls results were fairly even, across all year groups.

EMERGENCY PLANNING

A key role of our job at school is to ensure the safety of students while they are in our care. This is a role we take very seriously. The school engages the services of Wade Harrison, Safety Consultant, to review the school's Emergency Plan each year. Wade is coming in on May 17 to speak to the children about our emergency plans. We have two main plans, "lock down" or "evacuate". The children will know them as the GO or STAY procedure. We will be doing a trial of the "lock down" or STAY drill while Wade is at school. Each term we will practice either a "STAY" or "GO" drill to ensure we are prepared for possible events.
