POSITION INFORMATION

- Browns Bay School is a contributing school on Auckland's North Shore with a current roll of approximately 600.
- An Enrolment Scheme is in place.
- The school is of a 'single cell' nature and currently operates with six year level teams.
- The fixed term position will be from 24th June for the remainder of the 2019 school year.
- The appointee will be expected to take a full role in school and team activities including assistance with school related extra-curricular activities.
- The appointee will be required to undertake effective and appropriate programmes of work based on school policies and national curriculum guidelines.
- The appointee will be required to maintain on-going records of children's progress and report this progress to parents.
- The appointee will be required to contribute to curriculum teams.
- The appointee will bring to the position strong interpersonal skills a high level of commitment and motivation, and a high degree of competency in teaching practice.
- Applicants should present a curriculum vitae clearly indicating strengths, experience and interests as well as a preferred teaching level within the school.
- Applicants should include the name of at least TWO referees who may be contacted to seek or verify information.
