Dear Parents and Caregivers Kia Ora

Welcome back to Term 3. Today we hit 100 days of schooling for 2019!



This term has a full 10 week programme that the Teams have already started. The main Topics in each Year level are:

- Year 1 Science: Mix It, Heat It, Cool It
- o Year 2 Science: Mix It Up
- o Year 3 Science: H2O Solid, Liquid, Gas
- o Year 4 Legends and Birds in our Green Space
- o Year 5 Science: Chemical Science Investigator
- o Year 6 Long Bay For how long?

In other areas the sport programme will involve "Get, Set, Go" with the Junior children and Harbour Sport tutors, while students will compete in Rippa Rugby tournaments, Cluster Hockey and Netball competitions.

The ASB GETWISE https://www.getwise.co.nz/ is back on this term after being postponed in Term 2. The Getwise programme is an innovative financial literacy programme brought to schools by ASB. Workshops are taken by facilitators and the ideas shared with children are all age related. The programme will be seen by all classes and will run over the term.

We also have the ICAS Examinations in September challenging students in Writing, Spelling, English and Mathematics.

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CONFERENCES

Thank you for attending the interviews last term. Over the two days we hosted nearly 500 interviews between teachers, parents and student to share learning and achievement. These conferences are part of our formal process of reporting to parents. Parents are welcome to have meetings with teachers if you have any concerns or questions about your child. It is really helpful if you call or email for a time, as we have scheduled staff meetings on Monday and Tuesday after school.

TE AO MAORI DAY

On Friday next week, the Maori whanau group are involving our Maori students in a day to support Maori students in their cultural knowledge. The students will spend the day learning about the mana whenua and local story of Browns Bay, participating in kai hakari and a hangi meal, as well as participating in activities involving poi, harakeke and art. I would like to acknowledge the support of the Maori whanau in the preparation and organisation of the day.

ROAD SAFETY

Auckland Transport have provided some very clear brochures on road safety around schools.

I have reproduced part of the brochure to remind drivers what is not permitted outside schools. The Parking Officers will visit the school and issue fines for parking infringements, yet I would prefer it if they turned up and left without getting their tickets out.

I would like drivers to be considerate of other drivers and aware of the dangers traffic can be to the little ones. Please review the "bad" parking listed in the brochure and help us keep our children safe.

Park safely outside schools

Before and after school is a busy time for everyone. Parking rules help protect our children and keep them safe. Drivers who park illegally put our kids at risk.

This term parking officers will be on patrol outside your school to issue tickets to those who are illegally parked.
