


PRINCIPALS MESSAGE



PARENT – TEACHER CONFERENCES

The Mid – Year Reports will go out to parents via the @SCHOOL Parent Portal. Paper reports will no longer be sent home with your child. The new report format will show the data that was previously in the Data Booklet so these will also no longer be going home.

The reports will be available on Tuesday 21 July after school; along with a link to book a Conference with the teacher.

Conferences are in the second week (Wednesday 29 July and Thursday 30 July). The Mid-Year Report will focus on Next Steps as we have delayed formal assessments until later in the year. At the Conferences, teachers will be able to provide a "teacher judgement" on progress and achievement, this will be from observations, distance learning work and discussions with students – not from formal assessments.

COVID-19

Who needs to stay away?

Unless directed by the Medical Officer of Health, the only people who need to stay away are those who are:

MYKINDO CHANGES to POLI PAYMENTS (INSTANT BANK TRANSFERS)

We have been advised that a service fee of 1% (capped at \$3) will apply for myKindo top-ups using POLi (instant bank transfers) from 6 July 2020. Internet banking continues to be FREE.

You will see these top-up options:

Internet Banking (POLi) – will incur a 1% service fee (capped at \$3). Funds are instantly transferred.

Credit/Debit Card - will incur 2.5% and 50c service fee. Funds are instantly transferred. Visa, Mastercard, American Express, China Union Pay.

Internet Banking (at your bank) - FREE. Allow two days for processing of funds (normally next day). Orders can be automatically placed when the funds have cleared. Kindo is a Registered Bill Payee with all major banks (search 'Kindo' to avoid entering their bank account number when using internet banking).

You can set up an Auto Payment or top up additional funds to your myKindo balance to avoid topping up each time, which will streamline your next purchase if you'd like to do so. Questions? hello@mykindo.co.nz
