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
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BROWNS BAY SCHOOL LOCAL CURRICULUM

2023 NEW ZEALAND DANCE CHALLENGE

They had to learn the moves through 3 tutorials, to a specially created dance for the competition called MATARIKI. The groups then practised the choreography, so they could perform in a video to be submitted to the judges of the dance challenge. They decided to showcase Browns Bay School in their video. Rafe Sykes, a Year 6 student, videoed them in many different locations around the school while they performed the Matariki dance. Rafe, along with the help of Mrs Marychurch, then spent time editing and putting together the performance. EPRo8 TECHNOLOGY CHALLENGE 2023




BBS EPRO8 Technology Challenge 2023


