Dear Parents and Caregivers Kia Ora Koutou

I would like to welcome the families of new students who have enrolled at Browns Bay School. In particular, I would like to welcome our 'new' New Entrants in Room 1 who have joined the class with Kylie Van Der Westhuizen.

TERM 4

Term 4 finishes on Tuesday 15 December at 1.00pm and between now and then we have a busy educational programme for your children.

The Term 4 curriculum focus is **Choice / Kia Kaha** which focuses on Health and Social Studies. The Health component is taught alongside the Life Education experience and particularly with Harold! The Social Studies key understanding is **'we need to understand and celebrate the differences in our culture."** The various Year teams will be looking at this topic in different ways and we will share information with you through the class teacher.

Other major events happening across the school this term are Athletics, Waterwise and Jingle.

Term 4 is a very important term for a school as it is a time where we review student's progress and achievement in preparation for reporting to parents. It is important that children attend school regularly, so teachers have the time to get a valid and accurate assessment of your child's stage of learning.

TEACHER ONLY DAY

Teacher Only Day is on **Friday 23 October** (the Friday of Labour Day weekend). This Teacher Only Day is provided under the Primary Teachers Collective Agreement, in which teachers are entitled to eight Teacher Only Days before June 2022. On this day, the school is closed to all students.

Labour Day holiday is Monday 26 October and school will not be open.

TE AO MAORI DAY

On Friday (tomorrow), the Maori whanau group are involving our Maori students in a day to support Maori students in their cultural knowledge. The students will spend the day learning about the Mana whenua and will work with Kylie Engleback on an art piece for the school. NEW ZEALAND SHAKE OUT

New Zealand Shake Out, our National earthquake drill took place today at 9:30am and the whole school took part. At that time we asked everyone to Drop, Cover and Hold. We did not take part in the Tsunami hikoi as the school is above the inundation zone for a tsunami.

The children were asked to: Do the Drop, Cover, and Hold

- DROP down on your hands and knees. This protects you from falling but lets you move if you need to.
- COVER your head and neck (or your entire body if possible) under a sturdy table or desk (if it is within a few steps of you).
- HOLD on to your shelter (or your position to protect your head and neck) until the shaking stops. If the shaking shifts your shelter around, move with it.

PINK SHIRT DAY



PINK SHIRT (Anti-Bullying) Day is on Friday (tomorrow). Children will be talking about this with their class teachers.

To support this day we are suggesting children add a **SPLASH** of **PINK** to their school uniform eg: cap, headband, flower, ribbon, scarf, necktie, t-shirt (if they have one) etc., if they would like to. This is <u>not</u> a full mufti day.

At Browns Bay School we use the poster definition shown with our classes entitled "Is it Bullying?"

We will continue to support students and reinforce strategies to deal with bullying e.g. Kia Kaha programme and using your WITS (as another option).
