PROPERTY UPDATE

We were delighted to hear that Woodview Construction have been appointed the building contractor for our 12 classroom block build.



The construction services company has been involved in renovation and new builds within the education sector. Takapuna Grammar School's main block is one renovation they have just completed to a high level of workmanship. They currently have two other jobs on the North Shore, Torbay Primary School and Birkenhead Primary School. Being a North Shore company who have close connections to the school and area, they are enjoying a good run of 'local' work. We look forward to working with Woodview Construction.

The Build is scheduled to begin on Monday 01 March. Hone Retimana, our School Kaumatua, will be supporting us by blessing the building site at 7am on that day. We are inviting our Tamariki/Maori whanau to attend and afterwards, the school will have kai hakari/cup of tea and muffins for those attending the blessing. The Safety fence for the Build will be installed this Monday. The fence will follow the School boundary on Masterton Road from the Office to the far bottom corner. Masterton Road will be the main entrance for the construction team so I would recommend parents consider alternative entrances (e.g. Browns Bay Road, Hyde Road).

Rooms 1 to 7

The builders are planning to be back on site next week to complete the deck and bifold doors. The delay has been unfortunate and a result of working on an old building. During the installation of the doors it was noted that the brickwork around the doors had not been tied back as thoroughly when first installed (back in the 1930's). The brickwork has now been inspected and we have given the builders instructions on how to complete the work. The deck and bi-fold doors are expected to be completed soon which means the classrooms will then be accessible from the Junior court area.

SCHOOL EVENTS

TAIAOTEA STREAM

Browns Bay School students took part in protecting the tuna-eel in the Taiaotea stream recently. When students heard about the issue of the tuna-eel being fed and fished in Taiaotea Stream, they went into action. They defined the problem, sought advice from Whitebait Connection Mountains to Sea Conservation Trust and designed a solution in the form of signage with art and QR codes to educate local schools about how to protect this taonga. SCHOOL ASSEMBLIES

The School Assemblies happen every three weeks – Week 4, 7 and 10 and are now split with a Year 1-3 and Year 4-6 Assembly. The first Assembly is tomorrow with Year 3 and Year 6 the organising Teams.

The times are:

Year 1 – 3 09:45 – 10:30am Year 4 – 6 11:45 – 12:30pm

The Assembly presentations have been changed to accommodate this with the assemblies <u>during the term</u> focusing on certificates and the sharing of work and singing. Parents of certificate and trophy recipients are contacted prior to the event so they can be present.

The Assembly at the <u>end of each term</u> will have a Mini Year Group presentation by the organising year group and parents of that year group who are performing are especially invited.

School trophies will be available at ALL the Assemblies for the most deserving students regardless of year level (except the End of Year Assembly that is reserved for Year 6 students). We have introduced a Junior Values Award for the Year 1-3 Assembly.

STUDENT SAFETY - BEFORE SCHOOL

The school has the following arrangements for student supervision before school:

- Students will be supervised from 8.30am, unless they are at school for coaching or practice with a parent present as a coach or manager
- Students may be on site under parent supervision
- 8.30 am teachers are in classrooms with students having access to storage and toilets
- Teachers are on duty at the Browns Bay Road and Masterton Road crossings from 8.30 am to 8.50am
- Teacher on duty at car drop off / pick up zone (this is usually the Principal) from 8.40am
- Junior teachers are not on duty in the morning so they can be in their room to ensure there is a transition from parents before school

SKiDs operate a Before School programme in the Hall for children who need to be dropped off early.

STUDENT SAFETY – AFTER SCHOOL

The process around the school is:

- Parents are to collect children at 3pm or older students leave the school and walk or bike home
- Three teachers are on duty at the crossing until around 3.15 3.20pm
- Teacher on duty at car drop off / pick up zone (this is usually Deputy Principal or Principal)
- Principal will monitor playgrounds when possible after school (do walk through identified students not with parents are sent to the Office)
- Junior teachers are not on duty in the afternoon so they can be in their room to ensure there is a transition over to the parents/caregivers after school. Junior teachers monitor pick-ups after school and keep students with them until they are collected (either in the room or just outside)
- If a child is not collected from class they are brought to the Office and the Office staff will contact parents.

SKiDs collect younger students from classrooms and from a central collection area. Older students can go straight to SKIDS.
