PROPERTY UPDATE

We have been working closely with the Ministry of Education and Woodview Construction and are pleased to announce that progress is going very well with the New Build and things are starting to move quickly!

We are planning to move our Year 5 and 6 students into the building in about the third week of Term 3 – Monday 15 August. The students in the Year 5 classes (Rooms 18 to 21) will move into Level 1 (ground floor) and the Year 6 classes (Rooms 24 to 27) will move into Level 2 (first floor). The students will have an opportunity to visit and explore the building before they actually move in.

The Year 4 to 6 students watched a presentation on the building and asked lots of questions which I have answered on a <u>document that is on our website</u>. Amongst the questions asked were some great ones such as:

How many rooms are there? Will it be noisy? Where will our class be?

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Yesterday afternoon, the Community Constable came to visit the school to check out the school traffic flow on Masterton Road. I had requested this visit due to my concerns of the dangers of the blocked roads around the school, and the concerns expressed to me by our neighbours.

The Community Constable has advised that on **MASTERTON ROAD**, the practice of cars lining up to pull into the PICKUP – DROP OFF BAY must stop, and drivers are to keep moving until a space is available at the PICKUP – DROP OFF BAY or you must find a park elsewhere.

Please note:

- The cones will block the PICKUP DROP OFF BAY from 2.45pm to 3pm
- Cars in the PICKUP DROP OFF BAY will be asked to move on if they are waiting too long.
- Move to the front of the drop zone where possible
- Drivers are asked to stay in the car
- Organise children before leaving home if you want to use the drop zone. Children should be ready to exit the car with hair already done, jumpers on, bags handy and understand their role on arrival
- DO NOT use the drop zone if you need to get out of the car, please find a carpark

If you arrange for your child to be collected at the PICKUP – DROP OFF BAY, then school staff will always be there to supervise them. If the children are not collected, they are brought into the Office for safety.

I would appreciate your support with this change in Traffic Management.


TRAVELWISE – We are a gold school!

JUNIOR MATHEX COMPETITION 2022







Yesterday, Browns Bay School competed in the Junior Mathex Competition 2022 at Northcross Intermediate School. In the Junior Mathex Competition, you have to answer a series of 20 questions as fast as possible. 3 Browns Bay School teams of 4 competed with 45-50 other teams from over 15 schools. Team 1 achieved a record result of 100* points (full marks) in 17 minutes. They won with 13 of 30 minutes remaining. There was a time limit of 30 minutes, and the fastest team to complete the questions wins. The only person that can interact with the marker is the runner. The runner is the only person that can pick up and drop off questions. BBS Team 1 received medals (and a chance to boast to friends) and will be receiving a trophy that will shortly be delivered to Browns Bay School and the Team. BBS Team 2 & 3 were outstanding too. They tried their best and achieved 45* and 65* points, respectively. The people in Team 1 were all from Room 24, Year 6, and these people were: Jonathan, Owen, Sophie, and Yihan. Owen was the runner. In Team 2 the competitors were Lucas, Micah (runner), Aaron, and Peter. In Team 3 there were Alex, Edmund (runner), Edison, and Stewart. All these competitors played valiantly and best of all, showed all the BBS Values. In addition, BBS Team 3 was awarded 5 extra points for outstanding manners. All the runners did an excellent job, while Torbay School came second, and Oteha Valley School came third. BBS Team 1 are sure they have broken the record of the fastest time to complete the series of questions with full marks. Previously, the fastest team only took about 20 minutes to complete them compared to the 17mins BBS Team 1 took to finish. Well done to all the Teams that competed.
