

PRINCIPALS MESSAGE

Dear Parents and Caregivers Kia Ora Koutou

I hope you were able to spend some time together as a family on the first public holiday to celebrate Matariki last week.

The Teacher Only Day was a positive day for the staff. We started the day with Kataraina Simpkins who is a Kahui Ako Across School Leader and Kaitiaki Reo Māori / Te Manu Taki from Rangitoto College. They shared with us the information and planning for the Pipiwharauroa: Festival of Matauranga (Kahui Ako Event), which will take place on Tuesday 13 September at Rangitoto College.

This was followed by John Retimana (Kaumatua), discussing local Māori history in preparation for the new History curriculum.

The day was completed with Edwin de Ronde a Positive Behaviour for Learning facilitator leading the staff in discussing the PB4L programme. Browns Bay School has embarked on the Positive Behaviour for Learning journey in conjunction with the Ministry of Education. The Positive Behaviour for Learning School-Wide framework (PB4L School-Wide) is designed to help schools build a culture where positive behaviour and learning is a way of life.

One of the main benefits to Browns Bay School is that the PB4L team, in collaboration with all the school's staff, tailor the framework to suit our environment and cultural needs. This is not an off the shelf product but rather a framework that we developed together to ensure that it not only meets our needs as a school community but is enduring.

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS:

Nominations from Friday 15 July.

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It's Board election time again. Next term we will be electing Board members for the next three years. Nominations will open for the election of *FIVE* parent representatives to the school on *Friday 15 July*.

Call for Nominations: No later than 15 July
Supplementary Roll closes: Monday 01 August
Nominations close: Wednesday 03 August



If there are more nominations than the five vacancies, then parents and caregivers will receive an invitation to vote either electronically or by post.

Nominations can be made online through an email link provided in the Call for Nominations. However, a hard copy nomination form can also be obtained from the school office.

If you wish to stand for the board, it is recommended that you provide a candidate statement and photograph.

The electoral roll will be held at the school and can be viewed during normal school hours.

Browns Bay School has always been very fortunate in having a strong board of parents who provide governance and support for the education of our students. This year we have some long-standing members resigning and there will be vacancies. If you are interested in having a discussion about the board's role contact either:

PROPERTY UPDATE

We are planning to move our Year 5 and 6 students into the new building in about the third week of Term 3 to start Monday 15 August. The students in the Year 5 classes (Rooms 18 to 21) will move into Level 1 (ground floor) and the Year 6 classes (Rooms 24 to 27) will move into Level 2 (first floor). The students will have an opportunity to visit and explore the building before they actually move in.

Rooms 16, 17, 30 and 31 will also be moving classrooms as their "Portable" classrooms will be moved to other schools. The Room 16 and 17 children will move into the classrooms next to Room 14 and 15.

The Room 30 and 31 children will move to the classrooms by the swimming pool.

There is a change in our planning for sharing the Build with parents and we will advise of this plan once the Build is complete.

A Blessing of the New Build by our Kaumatua, John Retimana, is planned for Friday 05 August at 5am. A notice will be going out about this event early next term.


